# What are benefits for education and participation?

The services for education and participation support young people from low-income families so that they can make equal use of offers in schools, day care centres and for recreation.



## Excursions and trips with schools, day care centres and day care for children

The costs for excursions and trips lasting several days are covered, with the exception of pocket money.

## Travel expenses

Travel to school may be covered for full-time students in the secondary II level (also BBS)..

## Benefits for participation in social and cultural life in the community

Children and young people up to the age of 18 receive a lump sum of EUR 15 per month for club fees, courses, workshops or recreation. This benefit can be used by the individual as they choose.

## Lunch

Expenses for lunch in schools, day care centres or day care may be covered.

## Tutoring

Pupils can receive learning support in order to achieve the essential learning goals. This does not depend on whether the pupils is at risk of being promoted to a higher grade.

## School supplies

Pupils receive a lump sum for school materials in the school year on 01.08. and 01.02., which is adjusted annually.



## Who can receive the benefits?

The educational package applies to all families who draw

- Basic jobseekers allowance,
- Children's or housing allowance and child benefit,
- Social welfare or
- Benefits in accordance with the Asylum Seekers Benefits Act.

Anyone who does not receive any of the above services but is unable to cover the costs of education and participation themselves have the option of having their individual entitlement to education and participation services examined.

## How are the services provided?

The benefits are settled with the provider. You do not need to worry about billing. Only in exceptional cases will a subsequent refund be made to you personally.

The school supplies allowance and travel expenses are paid directly to you.

## How do I get the services?

The learning support (tutoring) must be applied for separately. For all other educational and participation benefits, the application can be made informally by specifically claiming individual needs.
